Johnetta Haley Scholarship, Transfer Terms and Conditions, 2024-2025

Award Details

The Johnetta Haley Scholarship is valid fall and spring semesters and will be continued, if renewal conditions are met, for four semesters of undergraduate study across two academic years. The award will be credited to the student's university account each semester. The scholarship may be applied toward charges in an SIUE professional program. By accepting this scholarship as part of the financial aid offer, the student agrees to the terms and conditions of the scholarship detailed herein.

Financial aid offers can be accessed through the student's CougarNet account. In order to secure the award, new students must pay the enrollment fee by June 1, and then register for Transfer Student Orientation. Continuing students must meet the criteria established for the award. One of the allotted four semesters may be applied toward costs associated with an SIUE-approved study abroad program up to the value of the scholarship for one term.

Johnetta Haley Scholarship in Combination with Other Awards & Financial Aid

The Johnetta Haley Scholarship will be applied to the student's account for university charges, such as tuition, fees, housing, and meal plan. The Johnetta Haley Scholarship will be considered an award to meet financial need in the packaging of financial aid. Should the crediting of the scholarship, in combination with other financial aid, result in excess funds on the student's account, the excess may be refunded to the student for personal expenses and books.

Academic Performance and Student Conduct

Continuance or renewal of the scholarship requires completion of full-time enrollment each semester (minimum 12 credit hours) and requires a 2.90 cumulative grade point average. In addition to the renewal requirements for the scholarship, Johnetta Haley Scholars must also abide by the University academic policy as stated in the catalog and student handbook at www.siue.edu/registrar, the Satisfactory Academic Progress Policy for financial aid and scholarship recipients at www.siue.edu/financialaid, and the Student Conduct Code at www.siue.edu/POLICIES.

Scholarship recipients should keep address changes up to date with the University and must check SIUE email often for important announcements.

Community Service

Haley Scholars are required to complete 12 hours of volunteer/community service learning activities each semester (24 hours each year). Students must register with the Student Opportunities for Academic Results (SOAR) Office at SIUE and provide documentation of service, including dates and hours, two weeks prior to the start of finals week each term to maintain scholarship eligibility.
